The MHS choral, band and orchestra teachers review the student applications and determine the recipient of the scholarship. As a teacher, Jim's primary objective was to instill a love of music that each of his students could enjoy throughout their lives and it was hi hope that this scholarship would help someone become a teacher who could do the same.

Eligibility for the E. James Forssell Scholarship:

- Cumulative GPA of 2.5 or above, determined at the end of the first semester of senior vear
- Acceptance into an accredited Community College or State University
- A completed application

Eligibility and Terms for all high school scholarships

- The applicant must graduate from Manatee High in the school year of his or her application
- The application must be legible and provide accurate information
- The application must be complete and meet the deadline
- If one or more of the preceding stipulations are not met the award may be forfeited
- The decision of the Manatee High Alumni Association is final
- Manatee High Alumni Association has the right to rescind a scholarship

- Consult with your Guidance Counselor to determine if you are eligible. Your Counselor must sign your application to verify your GPA
- 2. Thoroughly complete your application form
- 3. Except where signatures are required, all answers must be computer-generated or legibly printed
- 4. Enter N/A for questions that have no applicable answers
- 5. Do not use staples. Paper clips can be used and your name should appear on each page of the application.
- 6. Application package must include letter of acceptance from the College/University you plan to attend
- 7. Obtain a letter of recommendation from your music teacher at MHS. Must be in a sealed envelope with the signature of the teacher across the seal. May be delivered in any of the following manner.
